- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days after the

- 4 tions and medical equipment for the emergency treatment

- 7 (b) Consultation.—In carrying out subsection (a),
- 8 the Administrator shall, to the maximum extent possible,
- 9 follow the guidance of the Aerospace Medical Association.
