I am requesting funding for the Brunswick, MD Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant project in the Fiscal Year 2025 Energy & Water Development, & Related Agencies Appropriations Bill. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers - Baltimore District, 2 Hopkins Plaza, Baltimore, MD 21201.

If awarded, this funding would be used to improve both the water and wastewater treatment plants to increase efficiencies and include technology that would allow for increased capacity. These plants serve residents of the City of Brunswick (with a population just over 8000) as well as 200 Frederick and Washington county residents outside the city boundaries. This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will ensure safe clean drinking water and safe treatment of waste for the residents of the City of Brunswick and for those residents in Frederick and Washington counties served by our treatment plants.

This project has a federal nexus because it has been authorized by Section 8375 of the Water Resources Development Act, (PL 117-263). I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.
